Bids will be awarded during the June 22, 2010 City Council meeting. All bids **must** be labeled "Bleach Bid".

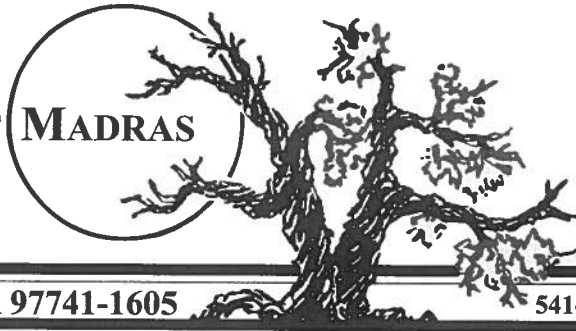
The City Wastewater Treatment Department is estimating the need for approximately 30,000-40,000 gallons of bulk 12.5% Sodium Hypochlorite (Bleach) in 1,000-3,000 gallon deliveries. The City would like to have a 1,500 gallon tank placed at each treatment plant.
