## BACKGROUND

Ordinance 976 was passed by the Council on June 27, 2023.

In accordance with ORS 195.500 through 195.505.

72 hr. Notice Required for established campsite.



## 9.30.030 Place and Manner Regulations

Time	<ul> <li>1 hr. after sunrise to 1 hr. before sunset.</li> </ul>
Place	<ul> <li>Camping is prohibited on all City property <ul> <li>Except those areas located at Willow Creek Camp /</li> </ul> </li> <li>City may require relocation for cleaning, maintenance, property.</li> </ul>
Manner	<ul> <li>Individuals engaged in camping may use a sleeping baused for bedding purposes.</li> <li>A camps are limited to a footprint of 150 sq. ft.</li> <li>Cooking stoves and other means of keeping warm may District.</li> </ul>
Special	<ul> <li>The City Administrator may temporarily authorize campion on City property by written order that specifies the perior and/or storage.</li> </ul>



# ALTERNATIVE CAMPSITE PREPARATION

- Coordination with Public Works to:
  - Prepare 3rd Street alternative campsite.
  - Placement of a storage container
- Storage of Personal Property Policy
  - Council approval?
- Storage for:
  - Personal property left behind
  - Items in sanitary condition
  - Medications, ID, money, etc.
- Storage NOT for:
  - Unsanitary items that will likely lead to injury or health problems for individuals in the vicinity.
- Coordination with Shelter for access to Exterior Bathroom & Showers

- <u>6/11/24 Campers will</u> <u>be required to vacate.</u>
- Police Dept. will patrol camp and cite anyone who returns.
