

NOTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH TITLE VI

In order to comply with 49 CFR Section 21.9 (d) the City of Madras has posted information for the public regarding the Title VI obligations and protections against discrimination afforded to the public by Title VI on the City of Madras website. The City of Madras has also posted the following notice of compliance with Title VI, which is visible to the public at City Hall and directs the public to the City website and to the appropriate phone number to inquire for more information. Notification of Compliance with Title VI

The City of Madras operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the City of Madras.

Our City Administrator's Office ensures that required notices of public hearings and opportunities to comment on proposed airport actions and transportation actions reach all segments of the impacted community. Such notices are announced over general and minority newspapers and broadcast media, where available and appropriate.

Our City Administrator's Office contacts leaders in affected communities directly and solicits their participation. The office maintains records of all such notices and the efforts made to reach the affected community.

To ensure that the community is effectively informed of and able to participate in public hearings, our City Recorder's Office advertises public notices in appropriate languages when a significant

number or proportion of the affected community has limited English proficiency. Such notices will include direction for obtaining an interpreter free of charge for the public hearing. 28 CFR § 42.405(d)
