Resolution No. R-014-18

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Board of Commissioners has adopted a weed control enforcement ordinance for the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.28.80 of that ordinance authorizes the Board of Commissioners to declare certain weeds to be noxious for purposes of the ordinance and to adopt a list of said weeds by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Weed Control Officer has recommended that certain weeds be declared noxious and that the Board adopt the recommended list;

NOW THEREFORE the Jefferson County Board of Commissioners does hereby RESOLVE as follows:

1. The Jefferson County Board of Commissioners hereby declares all of the weeds listed on the attached Weed List, Exhibit A, to be noxious and subject to the Weed Control Enforcement Ordinance of Jefferson County.
2. This Weed List shall replace all prior weed lists related to noxious weeds under the Weed Control Enforcement Ordinance.
